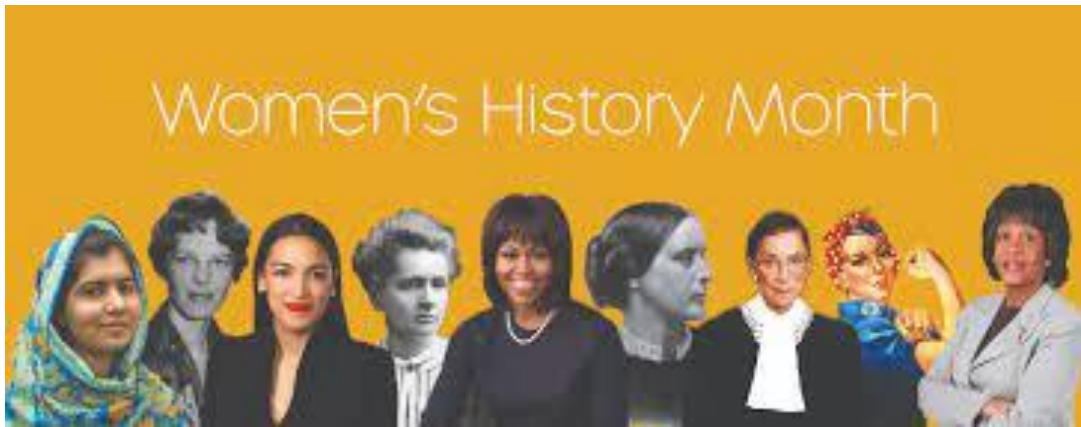
Beginning Monday, March 29th all remote students had the opportunity to return to in-person learning five days a week. Online learning will continue for students or families with remaining health-related concerns.

COVID VACCINATION CLINIC

If you are a Hartford resident, you can get your COVID 19 vaccine through St Francis Hospital at Parker Memorial Community Center

(Monday – Friday 8:20 -3:40 appointments)
(2621 Main St, Hartford)

Pre-registration is required

To Pre-register:

Call/Text **860-890-3161** or email - Advocacy2Legacy@gmail.com, Info needed to register is:

Name, address, phone #, date of birth, gender, race (optional)

Criteria: CT age registration requirement **OR** healthcare personnel, first responders, long term care facility residents or staff, residents and staff of congregate settings, educators and child-care providers. **Age requirements for registration:** current –ages 55+, March 22– ages 45+, April 5– ages 16+

Remember call/text **860-890-3161** to pre-register for COVID vaccine.

WHEN CAN I GET VACCINATED?

Residents 45 years old and older, and all previous phases, are now eligible to receive a COVID-19 vaccine.

OPEN NOW FOR 45+

Hartford residents, schedule your appointment by calling the Health Department at 860-757-4830 or the CT Vaccine Appointment Assist Line at 877-918-2224.

WHO IS NEXT ?

APRIL 5

Residents 16 years old and older. All CT residents over the age of 16 can register for the COVID-19 vaccine on April 5th, 2021.

As of 3.15.21

- ★ Sign up for a wait list, email alert, or text alert
- You will be directly notified when there is an appointment available
- ★ Check CVS and Walgreens regularly
- ★ Expand your search!
- Try looking farther outside of your region if you are able to travel
- ★ Try Vaccination Standby!
- This website sends text notifications when extra doses are available at vaccine centers
- ★ Don't be scared to call for extra help

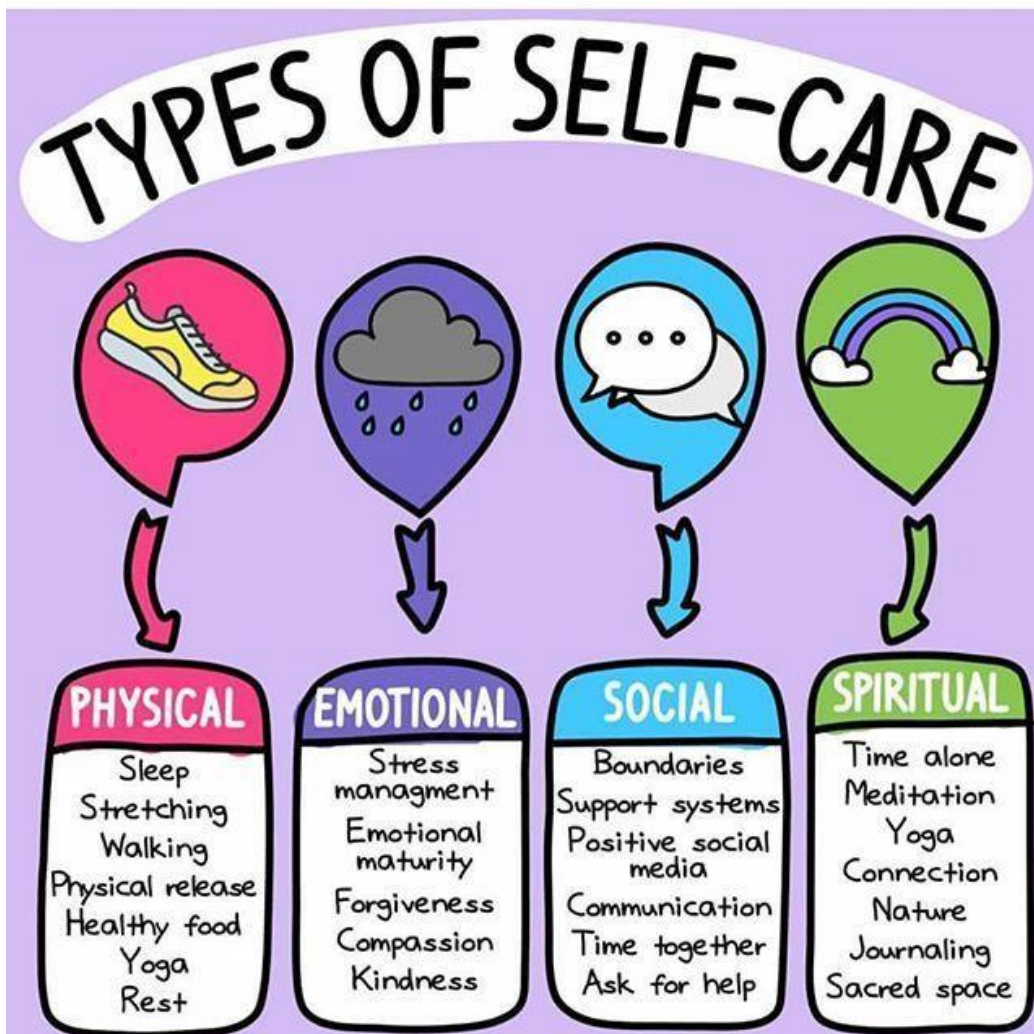
